



Energy Scheduling Issues Meeting

November 1, 2013

- PJM is working with MA to better understand the concerns and to develop process improvements where appropriate.
- Issue 1: Interface Pricing
 - PJM agrees that more discussion is required and to explore issues, options and potential impacts to any changes related to the IMO pricing point.
- Issue 2: Sham Scheduling
 - PJM agrees with Monitoring Analytics that Tags represent physical energy schedules and should be representative of real-time system flow. Greater transparency in support of MA's process to screen for partial schedules would be beneficial.
- Issue 3: Schedule versus Actual
 - PJM does not believe that RT SCED receives poor forecast data due to Transmission Service Requests (scheduled path) since RT SCED uses Tags (energy schedules) as the primary data source for interchange.
- PJM would like to see data associated with the magnitude of these issues.
