## Anyone attending PJM-sponsored meetings, trainings or events in person must be fully vaccinated.

- Fully vaccinated means two
  weeks after receiving the
  second dose in a two-dose
  series or two weeks after
  receiving a single-dose vaccine.
- Booster shots are not required per CDC guidance.

Individuals without proof of vaccination will be turned away.



- In-person attendees must register in advance of meetings.

  Please visit the *PJM Meeting Center* to register for meetings individually.

  Remote participation remains an option for all PJM meetings.
- Stay home if you are not feeling well or experiencing any COVID-19 symptoms.
- Arrive at the meeting location one-hour prior to the meeting's start to allow time to check in.
- Proof of COVID-19 vaccination and a valid government-issued ID\* must be presented at the PJM security desk.
- Masking is not currently required indoors. (Attendees must agree to adhere to applicable PJM and local COVID-19 policies in effect at the time of the event.)
  - \* Once you have provided proof of vaccination to attend an in-person meeting at PJM, you will not need to do so again.
