#### **Key Work Activities and Scope**

- 1. Education on the difference between internal and cross-border transmission service request
- 2. Education on how the transmission system is evaluated and maintained within the RTEP to ensure deliverability to all internal load from all internal generation sources.
- Education on the customer steps necessary to assign internal NITS and the challenges that may be encountered when applying the pro forma language to internal NITS

#### **Out of Scope**

- 1. Modification to border service processes associated with Network Integration Transmission Service (NITS)
- 2. Modification to the Regional Transmission Expansion Process (RTEP)
- 3. Modification to the pseudo-tie request process
- 4. Modification to transmission service rates
- 5. Modification of the process to integrate new service territory into PJM

- 1. Potential OATT revisions
- 2. Potential Manual revisions
