


DER Aggregation Marketing and Dispatch Functional Roles

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Proposed Operational Coordination Model



- **Market Agent** and **Dispatch Agent** could be EDC, DER Aggregator, or a 3rd party as assigned during the DER Aggregation registration process in accordance with RERRA / PUC and Utility requirements.
- Existing **PJM** to Transmission Operator communications remain in place but are not shown in this model.
- This model represents necessary **PJM** communications but is not necessarily inclusive of all communications required by the utility

Market Agent and **Dispatch Agent** could be EDC, DER Aggregator, or a 3rd party as assigned during the DER Aggregation registration process in accordance with RERRA / PUC and Utility requirements.

- PJM not intending to define “Market Agent” and “Dispatch Agent” in the Tariff as a part of this compliance filing.
- Potential to utilize existing Designation of Agent (DOA) process
 - Common process in PJM, but can be resource intensive
 - Unclear at this time whether this would be the best path forward


- Where state/local/utility regulations or agreements indicate that certain roles need to be fulfilled by someone other than the Aggregator, a process to designate those roles would need to be completed prior to the DERA operating in PJM markets.
 - Could be part of the registration process logic or market readiness checklist for DERA in certain jurisdictions, for example.
- PJM Membership required to fulfill these roles?
 - Unclear at this time.
 - Today, generator dispatch agents need to be PJM Operator Certified but not necessarily a PJM member, for example.

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
