administered retail access program and the wholesale load for which there is no contractual commitment.

Accounted-for Deficiency The amount by which an LSE's accounted-for obligation

exceeds its unforced capacity.

Accounted-for Excess The amount by which an LSE's unforced capacity exceeds

its accounted-for obligation.
