

## **Meeting Minutes**



Resource Adequacy Analysis Subcommittee PJM Conference and Training Center/ WebEx August 27, 2020 1:30 p.m. – 3:00 p.m. EPT

### **Administration**

1. Mr. Falin opened the meeting and reviewed the agenda. The meeting minutes from the July 30, 2020 meeting were approved and will be posted as final.

## 2020 Preliminary Results and Discussion

2. Mr. Rocha-Garrido presented the preliminary results of the 2020 Reserve Requirement Study (RRS) analysis. The 2020 Capacity Model is driving the decrease in the IRM. The Average EEFORd in the 2020 RRS (for DY 2024) is 5.78% whereas in the 2019 RRS (for DY 2023) was 6.03 %. The lower Average EEFORd in the 2020 RRS is caused by a lower average EEFORd of the generation classes more heavily represented in the study i.e., combined cycle units and gas turbines. The 2020 Capacity Benefit of Ties (CBOT) puts upward pressure on both the IRM and the FPR. The CBOT decreased from 1.6% (2019 RRS) to 1.5% (2020 RRS)
