2023 Load Model Time Period Assessment *

Mr. Rocha Garrido reviewed results of analysis performed by PJM staff regarding the selection of a load model time period for both PJM and the World regions. PJM recommended a 7 year (2013-2019) load model for the 2023 RRS Base Case and that the World peak be switched to a different July week so that PJM and World peak on the same month but not on the same week.

The RAAS endorsed the 2013-2019 load model for use in the 2023 RRS Base Case with no objections or abstentions.
