TO WHOM IT MAY CONCERN:

On Friday, September 19, 2014, between 12 p.m. and 2:00 p.m., certain persons accessed information inadvertently made available through PJM's Artificial Island Proposal Window Website. Specifically, a nonpublic, confidential version of Public Service Electric and Gas Company's *Response to PJM's Supplemental Proposal Request* was retrieved. As you may or may not be aware, section 18.17.1(a) of the Amended and Restated Operating Agreement of PJM Interconnection, L.L.C. (Operating Agreement), provides in relevant part that:

No member shall have a right hereunder to receive or review any documents, data or other information of another Member, including documents, data or other information provided to the Office of the Interconnection, to the extent such documents, data or information have been designated as confidential pursuant to the procedures adopted by the Office of the Interconnection and/or the PJM Market Monitor or to the extent that they have been designated as confidential by such other Member.

PJM understands that retrieval of the PSE&G data was inadvertent due to an error by a PJM employee and not due to any action taken by any person or company. However, the fact remains that access to such information may be a violation of section 18.17.1(a) of the Operating Agreement. Therefore, PJM requests that any person or company accessing such information immediately destroy it and refrain from using any of the information inadvertently obtained. To the extent any of the information was inadvertently obtained by any other entity or individual(s), you are required to retrieve all copies of that information, destroy them and advise the entities/individuals to whom you forwarded the information that they may not use that information for any purpose.
