

# Non-capacity market opportunities for seasonal Demand Response resources

Includes Problem/Opportunity Statement

#### **Issue Source**

A commitment to continue stakeholder discussions on seasonal resources was noted in PJM's enhanced aggregation filing (November 17, 2016; ER17-367-000). PJM Staff is bringing this problem/opportunity statement and issue charge to stakeholders for consideration.

# **Stakeholder Group Assignment**

Demand Response Subcommittee, Seasonal Capacity Resources Senior Task Force, or new senior task force.

### **Key Work Activities**

- Review analysis conducted by PJM's Resource Adequacy department which projects the impact of peak shaving resources on the load forecast used in RPM.
  - a. As applicable, recommend alternative assumptions and/or modified analysis procedures.
- 2. Education and discussion on specific Demand Response resource types or specific market rules that prevent participation in RPM.
- 3. Education and discussion on Demand Response resources that have the capability to reduce load on peak days at the direction of PJM.
- 4. Explore non-capacity wholesale market mechanisms to value Demand Response resource flexibility for those resources that may not be able to clear in the capacity market.

### **Expected Deliverables**

- Report to MRC on discussion and any proposed solutions to value seasonal Demand Response resources outside of RPM or through PJM's load forecasting processes.
- 2. If necessary, manual and/or tariff language associated with any approved proposals.

# **Expected Overall Duration of Work**

12 months

# **Decision-Making Method**

Preferred: Tier 1, consensus (unanimity) on a single proposal

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
