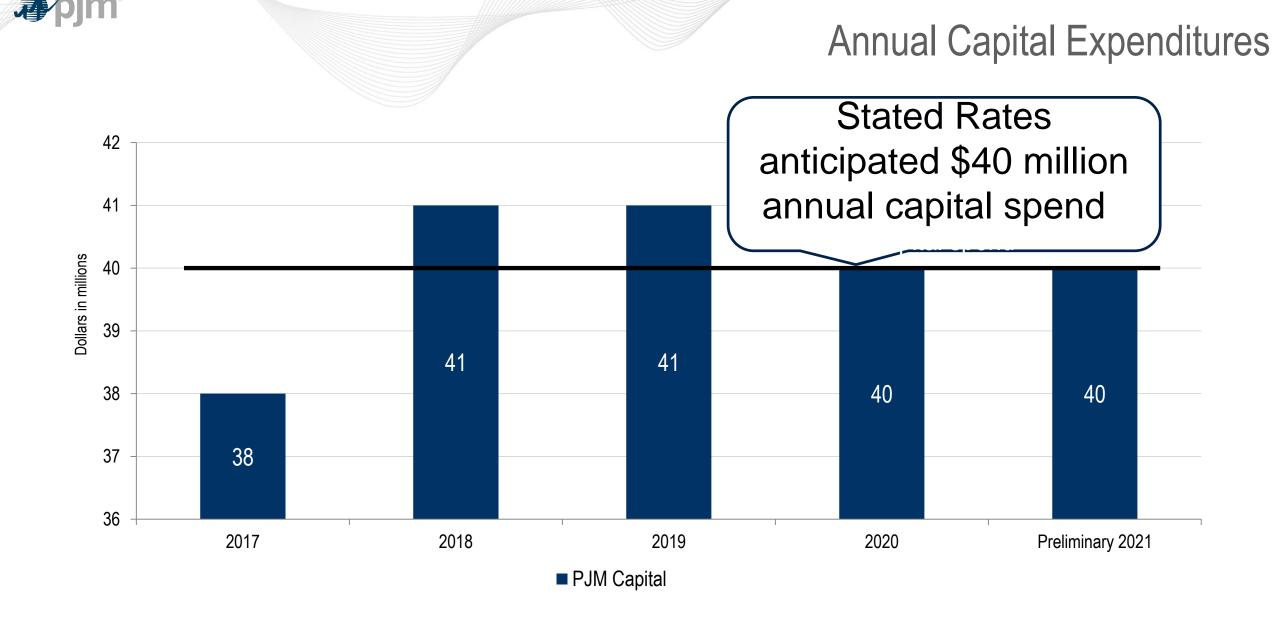

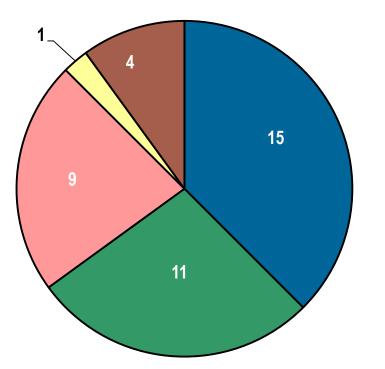

Market-to-Market Enhancements – This project will address work required for vulnerabilities identified in the dispatch management tool and updates to password encryption methodologies.

Market-to-Market Freeze Date – This project will update the historical transmission entitlements calculations to align with planning, markets and operations processes.

Automated Checkout – This project will automate the Net Schedule Interchange (NSI) checkout process between PJM and its neighboring balancing authorities.



Capital Initiatives Considered and Deferred

- Control Center Generator Replacement \$5.4M– Replacement of aging backup diesel generators for the control center building
- Hardware Replacements \$1.0M A series of purchases for aging computer hardware
- Market Application Enhancements \$1.0M A series of enhancements to existing Markets applications
