




# MISO – PJM Joint and Common Market Cross Border Transmission Planning

May 21, 2019

- RTOs held Annual Issues Review IPSAC March 29
  - Reviewed regional issues & solutions, 3<sup>rd</sup> party issues
  - Limited stakeholder feedback
  - Limited opportunities for interregional development identified beyond current IMEP study
- 2019 Coordinated System Plan:
  - Completion of 2018-2019 IMEP Study
  - Possible Interregional Reliability Project evaluation, if opportunity identified
  - No 2019 Targeted Market Efficiency Project (TMEP) study
  - No 2019 Ad Hoc studies

- Two-year, 2018-2019 IMEP Study
- Each RTO has developed an economic model, identified issues, and solicited upgrades
  - Overlapping border issues identified by both RTOs created several opportunities for interregional proposals
- Both RTOs are evaluating 10 solutions addressing 3 interregional drivers
- Regional MEP processes ongoing
  - PJM mid-cycle update and regional benefit analysis of proposed solutions
  - MISO regional benefit analysis of proposed solutions
