Dear Ms. Schleiden:

On August 26, 2011, you filed on behalf of PJM Interconnection, L.L.C. (PJM), revisions to Sections 1.5A.10 and 1.10.1A of Schedule 1 of the Amended and Restated operating Agreement (OA) as well as parallel provisions of the Appendix to Attachment K of the PJM Open Access Transmission Tariff (PJM OATT). You state that the revisions reduce the threshold for Regulation, Synchronized Reserve and Day-Ahead Scheduling Reserve market offers for all resources to include demand and generation resources and reduce the aggregation threshold for demand resources.

Pursuant to authority delegated to the Director, Division of Electric Power Regulation - East, under 18 C.F.R. § 375.307, your submittal filed in the above referenced docket is accepted for filing, effective October 25, 2011, as requested.

Notice of the filing was issued on August 29, 2011 with comments, protests, or interventions due on or before September 16, 2011. No protests or adverse comments were filed. Notices of intervention and unopposed timely filed motions to intervene are granted pursuant to Rule 214 of the Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedure (18 C.F.R. § 385.214).

This acceptance for filing shall not be construed as constituting approval of the referenced filing or of any rate, charge, classification or any rule, regulation, or practice affecting such rate or service contained in your filing; nor shall such acceptance be

deemed as recognition of any claimed contractual right or obligation associated therewith; and such acceptance is without prejudice to any findings or orders which have been or any which may hereafter be made by the Commission in any proceeding now pending or hereafter instituted by or against PJM.

This order constitutes final agency action. Requests for rehearing by the Commission may be filed within 30 days of the date of issuance of this order, pursuant to 18 C.F.R. § 385.713.
