RE: Support of PHI's MAPP project

Dear Mr. Boston and Board of Managers:

Old Dominion Electric Cooperative (ODEC) requests the PJM Board of Managers approve the High Voltage Direct Current (HVDC) modification to the MAPP project without further delay.

PJM staff's October 2007 request to consider this modification has been thoroughly assessed by PJM, PHI, ODEC and other wholesale providers on the Delmarva Peninsula. The HVDC option further enhances the reliability benefits of this project by:

- Improved AC system stability
- Improved AC system damping
- Improved response to contingencies via controlled power flow
- Improved voltage support and frequency control
- Controlling loop flows


PJM staff's recommended HVDC option has proved to be a good suggestion. PHI has done an excellent job in working closely with the many load servers in the Delmarva Peninsula to craft an efficient and cost-effective collaborative solution. This is precisely the type of regional planning the Board should expect from its RTO.
