Dear Mr. Boston and Board of Managers:

A & N Electric Cooperative (ANEC) is one of the member-owners of Old Dominion Electric Cooperative. We are a not-for-profit, member-owned energy provider serving over 30,000 homes, farms and businesses in the counties of Accomack and Northampton in Virginia and Somerset County, Maryland. We are writing to express our strong support for the MAPP project.

Provision of a second source of power to the Delmarva Peninsula will provide innumerable reliability benefits for this historically transmission-deficient area. Modification of a portion of the line to High Voltage Direct Current (HVDC) technology further enhances the value of this project with improved ability to respond to contingencies via controlled power flows and minimize loop flows.

We understand the original AC version of this project was approved by the Board of Managers in October of 2007 and that consideration of this HVDC modification was undertaken at the request of PJM. PJM staff and PHI have thoroughly evaluated this modification and support its implementation. We ask the Board of Managers to approve this enhancement during its upcoming meeting so work can begin to meet the 2013 in-service date.
