The Public Service Commission of the District of Columbia ("DCPSC") hereby endorses the position with regard to Price Responsive Demand ("PRD") expressed by the Public Utilities Commission of Ohio ("PUCO") in its letter of November 12, 2010.

Like the PUCO, the DCPSC is exploring options for dynamic pricing, to take advantage of new smart metering technology which is currently being deployed throughout the District. We feel it is vitally important that wholesale pricing mechanisms be designed to fully compensate retail dynamic pricing for the value it provides in reducing utilities' capacity obligations.

We appreciate the attention to this matter and look forward to working with PJM and the Members Committee on the coordination of wholesale and retail PRD policies.
