Exelon wishes to provide comments to the PJM Board on the work of the RPPTF to review possible changes to the PJM RTEP, including how to incorporate public policy laws, rules and regulations into the PJM RTEP process. Exelon supports continuation of the work of this Task Force to review how the RTEP process can be improved; with the goal of presenting recommendations to the stakeholders and ultimately to the PJM Board. While Exelon has stated publicly that RTOs should not set public policy, that does not mean that PJM should not plan its transmission system to provide reliable and economic service to customers consistent with implementation of public policy of the federal and state governments. In fact, in Exelon's opinion, the question is not whether PJM should include public policy assumptions in development of the RTEP, but how to do so.
