On October 18, 2010, the Maryland Public Service Commission (MDPSC) sent a letter to Michael Kormos, Chairman of PJM's Markets and Reliability Committee, expressing MDPSC's strong support for including a "summer-only unlimited" option for demand response capacity resources in any package of demand response reforms that PJM forwards to the FERC.

The OPSI Board of Directors, at its monthly Board Meeting yesterday, expressed its support for the MDPSC position as stated in the MDPSC letter.<sup>1</sup> Notwithstanding any vote on this matter at the PJM Members Committee on November 18, 2010, the OPSI Board of Directors urges the PJM Board of Managers to act in accordance to the MDPSC recommendation.
