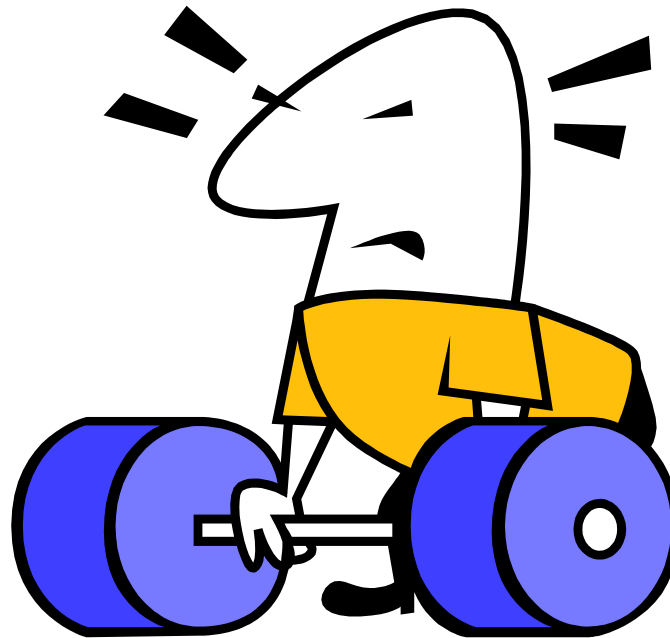

- Scheduled Release Date: August 29, 2005.
- Difference Check based on Absolute Value.
 - Tolerance Values will now be Positive Numbers.
 - If $|\text{Difference}| > \text{Tolerance}$ row will be **RED** or **YELLOW**.

- **Handling Active Tickets**
 - When an active ticket has an estimated end date in the future, this ticket should only be used up until the ticket Est. End Date.
 - When an active ticket has an estimated end date in the past, this ticket should only be used in the calculation through the current period.

- Acknowledgements to be allowed on both Today and Tomorrow Reports.
- Allow Generator MW Outage Maintenance Tickets for longer than five business days during the summer.
- Column headings will be repeated throughout report so that always visible when scrolling through report

- Ambient Air Tickets **DO NOT** need to be entered unless the row is in **RED.**



- Calculations for Adjusted Capacity are the following:
 - Calculation for Adj. Cap. under Economic Conditions is $ICAP + \text{Ambient Air} - \text{Reductions} - \text{Incremental}$
 - Incremental = $\text{Emergency Max} - \text{Economic Max}$
 - Calculation for Adj. Cap. under Emergency Conditions is $ICAP + \text{Ambient Air} - \text{Reductions}$



- Ambient Air Tickets can be entered for periods longer than a month.



- You still must call the PJM Scheduling Coordinator or enter Switch Dates to officially Start or Stop an Outage.
