At the PJM Annual Meeting at The Greenbrier in West Virginia last month, I had mentioned that OPSI was going to attempt to issue a position paper on PJM's cost allocation methodology. Since then, I have had informal discussions with some OPSI members and we have realized that certain commissions' counsels have advised their commissioners not to take any position as they have transmission proceedings pending before them and certain commissions have filed individual positions before the FERC in EL05-121. As such, at this time, OPSI will not be issuing any position paper on cost allocation so as to allow our members retain their individual state position on this issue.
