PJM is planning on implementing an eSuite application upgrade on March 30, 2009 beginning at 18:50 EDT. There may be up to a 5 hour outage, during which, EES and OASIS will experience the following impacts:

EES

EES will be completely unavailable during the outage. Users will be unable to create or modify ramp reservations, create or modify two-settlement schedules, view available ramp, or utilize the EES browserless API to submit their data. The [JCM MISO-PJM Ramp Data](#) page will also be unavailable.

OASIS

For users already logged in to the OASIS there will be no disruption; however, users attempting to log in for the first time during the outage will be unable to do so via the normal methods. Rather, all new logins should utilize <https://pjmoasis.pjm.com/oas/oasis.html>. HTTP template requests will continue to function without disruption during the maintenance window.

All users are encouraged to take appropriate measures prior to the outage to ensure that their external scheduling activities are not disrupted. This includes the purchase of OASIS reservations and the preemptive submission of tags wherever possible.

Effective 3/1/2008, the maximum and minimum bid value of Up-To-Congestion has changed. Market participants can now bid up to \$50/MWh and can bid no less than -\$50/MWh.
