# Introduction

- Committee Voting is a secure PJM web application that allows users to submit votes during PJM committee meetings
  - Used by both remote and on-site meeting attendees
- To be implemented in September 2010
- Initially utilized only for Members Committee (MC) voting

- WebEx voting no longer utilized for committees using new Committee Voting application
- Voting boxes and phone voting still available where currently used
  - Eliminates need for users voting for multiple companies to use multiple voting boxes
  - Phone voting to be discontinued for committees using the Committee Voting application in January 2011
- Streamlines quorum establishment and vote tallying and reporting

- All eligible voters may vote via the Committee Voting application
  - User must be a primary or alternate on the roster for that committee
  - Or
  - User must be designated as a voter for a specific meeting by a roster member
- Must have an eSuite account

# Committee Voting Access

- Committee Voting will be accessible via the PJM eSuite homepage
  - eSuite username and password required to access the application
- PJM will create eSuite accounts for all voters on the MC roster as of September 2010 and notify members upon completion

- Voters that are eligible to vote for multiple companies will vote for all companies through a single Committee Voting account
  - Each such user should only set up one eSuite account with Committee Voting privileges
  - PJM Member Logistics will ensure that such users can vote for all eligible companies through the designated account

- **Read/Write User**
  - Ability to submit votes
  - Ability to view votes for current and past meetings
  - Read/Write access alone does not grant a user permission to vote at committee meetings
    - User must be an eligible voter as well (primary, alternate or designate)
- **Read Only User**
  - Ability to view votes for current and past meetings



# Read Only & Read/Write Users: Company authorizations & forms

- PJM member companies with eligibility to vote at the Members Committee meeting will have grandfathered authorization to use the Committee Voting Application
- Each member company will be responsible for registering individual Committee Voting users via the eSuite registration process
  - Exception: Accounts with Committee Voting Read/Write access will be created for all primary and alternate MC roster members as of September 2010

## Authorization to Use PJM Internet Business Tools

### To PJM Customers:

In order to ensure necessary security with business transactions, PJM requires explicit authorization for users of PJM Internet business tools. Authorization can be made by a company representative, i.e., an officer of the company or the Member Committee Representative. "CAM Form A" (this form) and "CAM Form B" must be signed for initial start up of your company's primary account. "CAM Form B" is used to designate the personnel in your company authorized as Customer Account Managers (CAM). A minimum of two CAMs must be designated per member company account. **The authorized CAMs will be the account administrators for your company. Use only "CAM Form B" for subsequent CAM personnel changes or request to create secondary accounts (sub accounts).**
