**PJM PROMOTES ANDREW OTT
TO SENIOR VICE PRESIDENT–MARKETS**

(Valley Forge, Pa. – May 1, 2008) – The Board of PJM Interconnection, the grid operator for 51 million people in 13 states and the District of Columbia, has promoted Andrew Ott to the post of senior vice president – markets. The announcement was made today at PJM’s annual members meeting in Williamsburg, Va.

Ott previous was the vice president – Markets.

In announcing the promotion, PJM CEO Terry Boston said that Ott, in his new role, will seek ways to further the integration of markets with reliability operations. “Given the economic and reliability benefits for the region, it makes sense for us to exploit to the fullest extent possible the synergies that exist in markets and operations,” Boston said.

Ott, who joined PJM in 1996 from GPU, was responsible for implementation of PJM’s locational marginal pricing, financial transmission rights and the Day-Ahead Energy Market systems. He received a Bachelor of Science degree in electrical engineering from The Pennsylvania State University and a master of science degree in applied statistics from Villanova University.
