PJM reported in February that we are responding to stakeholder feedback about PJM.com to correct bugs that have been reported and to improve the features and functionality of our Web site. By working continuously to address these issues, PJM has made several enhancements to PJM.com.

Committee calendar events are now viewable past May to allow members and stakeholders to plan ahead. Training Events and the Course Catalog now only display upcoming training events; outdated materials have been removed. Committee meeting materials from prior to 2009 are now available for your reference.

In addition, the mobile version of the Web site has been improved to offer a streamlined view of PJM.com on handheld devices such as PDAs and Blackberry® devices. Server errors received by Web site users have been resolved and will continue to be monitored.
