Markets Gateway is the tool replacing the legacy eMKT tool as part of PJM's commitment to simplify members' interaction with PJM. While no functionality or business rules have been changed in the development of Markets Gateway, new security controls will impact participants implementing browserless communications with the application. Interested participants are strongly encouraged to log into the application in PJM's Sandbox environment to become familiar with Markets Gateway and test any browserless functionality. The Markets Gateway page on pim.com has documentation to help transition between the two applications.
