

Markets & Reliability Committee Meeting Transmission Replacement Senior Task Force (TRPSTF) Status Update & Guidance



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In response to the FERC Order to Show Cause¹, the majority of TRPSTF scope was suspended and placed on hiatus as agreed by all parties until the sooner of i) a FERC issued order or ii) March 2017.

- A limited scope element, a Transmission Cost Information Center (TCIC) has continued as it was determined not responsive to the Order and would create value and clarity to upcoming transmission investment.
- A sample calculation worksheet and detailed requirements document have been developed.
- Final review and edits are to occur on February 24 and a subsequent poll/vote is anticipated shortly thereafter.

Solicitation of MRC Guidance and PJM Recommendation

- The Show Cause Order focus and principles leading to the MRC determination to place the TRPSTF scope on hiatus remain.
- Changes in FERC Commission composition and the loss of a quorum were unanticipated.
 The Commission's findings on this matter may have a direct bearing on the issues, content and timing of any directives resulting from the Order to Show Cause².
- As both Transmission Customers and Transmission Owners are similarly situated by the uncertainty related to the Order, PJM recommends the deferral of TRPSTF resumption by at least one month.
- Assuming i) the commitment to ensure the resumption of TRPSTF efforts and ii) MRC discussion, guidance and vote, PJM is able to support other deferral options such as:
 - Month-to-month, 3 month, 3 month deferral followed by month-to-month or a 6 month deferral
