



**PJM Interconnection**  
**Summary of the SIS Meeting for the January OC Meeting**  
**955 Jefferson Avenue**

**January 18, 2011**

**1. PJM OPERATIONS, EDART AND ESUITE**

Mr. Jerry Whooley reviewed the status of the eSuite applications. Two new reports were released in MSRS. An outage is scheduled for January 15th to enable a major server upgrade to the eDART servers.

**2. COMMUNICATION & SYSTEMS ISSUES**

Mr. Graff led the discussion on communication and system issues. A question was raised on how PJM prefers to receive data from solar installations. There are a number of small solar installations being put in place, such as pole tops. Mr. Graff will provide the answer at the next SIS meeting.

**3. PJMNET LINK OUTAGE REPORT**

Mr. Rich Glaum provided an update on the link outage reports for November. November was an extremely good month.

Mr. Glaum provided an update on action items #473 and #474. The escalation path is likely to consist of two routes; one escalation path for planned outages, and another escalation path for emergency outages. Mr. Glaum commented that emergency outages are controlled by the lead dispatcher; in such events, the lead dispatcher is charged by NERC and FERC with ensuring reliable operations. If a requested outage is cancelled by PJM, PJM should provide reasons for the



cancellation e.g., what are the system conditions that exist? Also, PJM should estimate when the situation may be rectified.

**4. PJM'S NEW EMS (AC<sup>2</sup>) UPDATE**

Mr. John Collier and Mr. John Smith provided an update on the AC<sup>2</sup> project, focusing on SOW#3 (EMS).

**5. REVIEW OF SOS REPORTS**

The SOS reports were presented and reviewed for November. There were no comments.
