



SOS Summary
April 13, 2011

1. ADMINISTRATION

- A. Mr. Keech reviewed the changes to the SOS Chair and Secretary.
- B. Mr. Keech proposed to change the registration login for SOS-T meeting on a monthly basis to improve security.

2. REVIEW OF OPERATIONS

- A. Mr. Keech provided an update of System Operations. An event occurred on 4/11/11 in the Surry area of Dominion. PJM System Planning is performing an analysis of the event.
- B. Member Operational Issues
 - a. Mr. Skumanich raised a question about the action for a high voltage event during a light load period.

3. WORKING GROUP UPDATES

- A. eDART User Groups – Mr. Deloach gave an update on eDart changes for the upcoming releases.
- B. Black Start Service Task Force (BSSTF) - Mr. Schweizer gave an update on the groups' activities. The group continues to work on the new black start refurbishment process. The other charter items on fuel storage and lost opportunity cost for pump hydro units were withdrawn. The CIP Costs Additive to Existing Rates proposal was approved by the MC.
- C. Dispatcher Training Subcommittee (DTS) – No update was provided.

4. SYSTEM OPERATOR TRAINING AND CERTIFICATION

Mr. Hoang reviewed an update from Mr. Gross on the System Operator Seminar.

Results of System Operator Training and Certification using LMS were reviewed.

91 MOCs were evaluated:

With respect to Training and Certification, 8 companies were non-compliance

With respect to Training, 6 companies were non-compliance

With respect to Certification, 5 companies were non-compliance

17 LCCs were evaluated:

With respect to Training, 0 companies were non-compliance

With respect to Certification, 1 company was non-compliance



Mr. Skumanich raised an issue with the LMS system where new trainee accounts led to the system reporting a company as non-compliant. It was suggested that the LMS system should have a checkbox to indicate a new trainee. PJM will follow up.

5. SPS REVIEW

Mr. Tribett discussed the Brandon Shores SPS. The SPS will trip a Brandon Shores unit when it detects an overload condition on either the Brandon Shores-Riverside 2344 or 2345 line. The SPS is expected to be in service by the end of July 2011.

6. REGIONAL STANDARDS, NAESB, AND COMPLIANCE UPDATE

- A. Mr. Harm gave an update on NERC, SERC, RFC, and NAESB Regional Standards. It was noted that members review the standard postings and comment as necessary. The onsite FERC Audit is scheduled for the week of May 16th.
- B. The SOS will address any ongoing member issues regarding NERC/RFC Audits. No issues were raised.

7. REACTIVE CURVE VERIFICATION

Mr. Schweizer reviewed the D-curve data acknowledgement update.

8. MANUAL REVIEWS & UPDATES

- A. Mr. Keech reviewed pending Manual changes. It was suggested that the color-coding in M13: Section 4 will need to be changed to reflect Homeland Security's.
- B. Mr. Schweizer reviewed changes to Manual 14D and the proposed language for AVR status reporting requirements.

Members expressed the need for additional manual changes to handle AVR situations when units are offline for a planned outage.

9. FUTURE AGENDA ITEMS

- A. PJM will provide an update of the operational event on 4/11/11 – Adam Keech
- B. Item for reporting SPS status
- C. Annual Review of Manuals M-01 (March), M-03 (April), M-13 (May), M-36(June), and M-12 (July) as well as all Restoration Manuals (April or May)



10. REVIEW OF OPERATIONS

- A. SOS-T reviewed operational events and concerns.
 - 1) Mr. Keech provided an update of System Operations. An operational event occurred on 4/11/11 in the Surry area of Dominion. PJM will provide an update of the analysis.
 - 2) Mr. Hunt reviewed the operating conditions leading up to the event.

11. SYSTEM ANALYSIS AND COORDINATION

- A. Mr. Souder reviewed May and Fall EHV outages.
- B. Mr. Souder also discussed a proposed PJM automation to help identify conflicting outages within eDART as new outage tickets are submitted.
- C. Mr. Souder provided an update to NRITF activities. The NRITF Compliance Bulletin was posted and that outage and derate postings related to the recent NERC Alert are a subset of all existing outage and derate postings.
- D. Mr. Smolanitsky reviewed and sought approval for the new line designations of 541 for the Morrisville-Royal 500 kV line and 592 for Royal-Warren 500 line. The new line designations were approved.

12. EMS MODELING AND DATA REQUIREMENT

Ms. Carter discussed the concern for the need to provide modeling data and outage tickets for distribution equipment. It was mentioned that outage reporting is needed to meet BES requirement.

13. DTS ITEMS

Mr. Lloyd provided an update on the Seminar. Issues/concerns from the SOS members for consideration at the DTS meeting will be brought to the attention of Mr. Lloyd, the SOS rep to the DTS.

14. RESTORATION PLAN UPDATE

Mr. Schweizer reviewed a change to the Dominion restoration plan due to the retirement Chesapeake #7 and reported that the Holtwood exception was extended to 12/1/11.
