



# FERC Order 890 Compliance Filing

- On August 13, 2008 PJM submitted revisions to its transmission planning process in accordance with Order No. 890 and FERC's May 15, 2008 order.
- May 21, 2009 Order. FERC accepted PJM's transmission planning process subject to further compliance:
  - Include a requirement that transmission owners provide the **models** used in developing their Local Plans; and
  - Provide the **opportunity for earlier stakeholder participation** in the Local Plans and prior to finalizing and presenting the Local Plans to the PJM Subregional Committee.
- PJM requested and was granted an extension of time from July 19 to September 28, 2009 to make its compliance filing.

- Revisions to Schedule 6 of the Operating Agreement (OA), Sections 1.5.4 (a) and (g) to provide that the models each transmission owner uses in its planning process will be made available, consistent with confidentiality restrictions or copyright limitations, in addition to the criteria and assumptions the transmission owner uses in its local planning.
- Revisions to Schedule 6 of the OA, Sections 1.3 (d) and (f) to provide the opportunity for stakeholders to review and comment on the criteria, assumptions and models used in local planning activities (i) prior to finalization of the Local Plan and (ii) on the Local Plan prior to it being submitted to the Subregional RTEP Committee.
