- Creation of new agreements which build upon our existing JOAs
 - Neighboring TOPs/BAs and their adjoining TOs
- Strengthen coordination of the operation of the transmission system and further enhance compliance
- NERC standards require agreements with neighbors to maintain reliable operation of the grid
 - BAL, EOP, FAC, MOD, TOP, TPL, PRC

- Establish agreement language pertaining to the existing points of interconnection that are mutually beneficial for the Parties

- Provide more clarity and detail
 - Use of Coordination guide – identifies applicable NERC standards

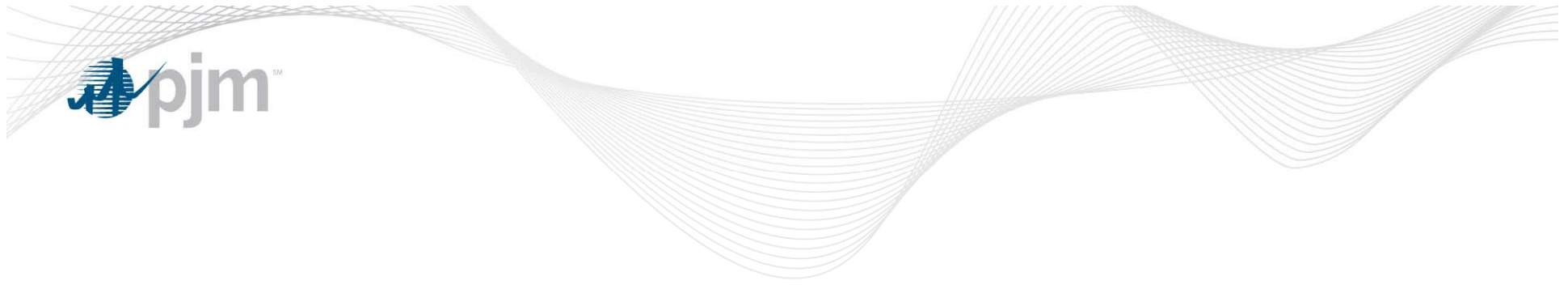
- Link to ATC/ComEd/MISO/PJM agreement
