

EDART STATUS UPDATE – DTTF/SIS/SOS MEETING

I. February 15th Release

- Transmission Outage Ticket Enhancements (**Testing**)
 - Changes to the Submit On Time rules to implement the following:
 - 6-Month Rule: “The TO is required to submit all outage requests in excess of 5 days in duration by the 1st of the month six months in advance of the start of the outage .” M03
 - 30-Day Rule: “Outages scheduled for the following Planning year (i.e. June 1 – May 31) exceeding 30 days in duration are to be submitted via eDART by February 1 for use in the annual FTR auction unless the 6-month rule is more restrictive.” M03

II. February 28th Release

- Telemetry Application Overhaul (**Design**)
 - Reinstatement of application.
 - Changes to application to remove object id assignment, requesting and authorization.
 - Addition to notification functionality to include buses, loads and other types.

III. March Release

- Transmission Outage Ticket Enhancements (**Design**)
 - Addition of ‘Potentially Incomplete’ flag to identify tickets for which PJM needs more information on the facilities to be impacted or more information about the outage in the Description field.
- Infrastructure Upgrade.

IV. May Release

- Transmission Outage Ticket Enhancements (**Design**)
 - Addition of functionality to determine conflicting transmission outages as discussed during the 11/17 EDUG-T meeting. Details available on slides 23-28 of that meeting presentation posted on the user group page.

V. Discussion Topics

- Overview of updated release schedule.
- Meetings will be scheduled in February to review details of upcoming enhancements with the eDART XML Users Group and the eDART Users Group.
