**ANSWER OF PJM INTERCONNECTION, L.L.C. IN SUPPORT OF  
NIPSCO MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME**

Pursuant to Rule 213 of the Commission’s Rules of Practice and Procedure,<sup>1</sup> PJM Interconnection, L.L.C. (“PJM”) submits this answer in support of Northern Indiana Public Service Company’s (“NIPSCO”) motion for extension of the comment date,<sup>2</sup> from March 29, 2010, to April 12, 2010, on the Midwest Independent Transmission System Operator, Inc.’s (“Midwest ISO”) two complaints against PJM regarding disputes arising under the Joint Operating Agreement between PJM and the Midwest ISO (“JOA”),<sup>3</sup> provided that the extension applies to all parties, including respondent PJM. PJM supports NIPSCO’s request for an extension of time because, as NIPSCO states, it will
