**Re: PJM Interconnection, L.L.C. and
American Transmission Systems, Incorporated
Docket No. ER11-2815-003
Errata to Compliance Filing: Technical Correction Only
to Correct Mapping of OATT Attachment H-21 and H-21A**

On June 30, 2011, in compliance with the Commission's May 31, 2011 order in these proceedings (the "June 30 Compliance Filing"),¹ American Transmission Systems, Incorporated ("ATSI") filed modifications to the PJM Open Access Transmission Tariff ("PJM OATT") in connection with ATSI's integration into PJM effective June 1, 2011. This instant filing is being submitted as an errata filing to correct an administrative and technical error in the Compliance Filing submitted on June 30, 2011 under Docket No. ER11-2815-002. In that filing, language properly identified in the transmittal letter and clean and marked tariff attachments as a revised version of Attachment H-21A was mistakenly submitted with metadata that led it to be placed in the OATT as a revised version of Attachment H-21. By resubmitting the tariff records in question with corrected metadata, this filing will move the Attachment H-21A language to its proper location and restore the correct version of Attachment H-21. No textual or substantive changes are being made in this errata filing to the tariff sections.

I. Background

On August 17, 2009, ATSI submitted a filing with the Commission requesting that the Commission approve, subject to satisfaction of certain requirements, ATSI's withdrawal from the Midwest ISO and its integration into PJM effective June 1, 2011.

On December 17, 2009, the Commission approved, subject to certain conditions, ATSI's request to withdraw from the Midwest ISO and join PJM.²

On February 1, 2011, PJM and ATSI jointly submitted modifications to the PJM OATT in connection with ATSI's integration into PJM ("February 1 Filing"). In the February 1 Filing, PJM submitted modifications to the PJM OATT, the Amended and Restated Operating Agreement of PJM Interconnection, L.L.C., the Reliability Assurance Agreement Among Load Serving Entities in the PJM Region and the Consolidated Transmission Owners Agreement.

On May 31, 2011, the Commission accepted the February 1, 2011 filing, subject to a compliance filing. On June 30, 2011, ATSI submitted a compliance filing with the Commission under Docket Nos. ER11-2814-002 and ER11-2815-002 pursuant to the Commission's May 31 Order. It recently came to PJM's attention that OATT Attachment H-21 and OATT Attachment H-21A were incorrectly mapped in the compliance filing submitted in Docket No. ER11-2815-002 on June 30, 2011, leading to incorrect placement of the Attachment H-21A language in the location of Attachment H-21, as noted above.

II. Description of Filing

This filing simply corrects the mapping errors for OATT Attachment H-21 and OATT Attachment H-21A. Only the tariff records in RTF form with corrected metadata are being resubmitted with this filing. The attachments showing clean and marked tariff language for these tariff sections are not being resubmitted because they have only been remapped to the correct location in the PJM OATT eTariff database and there are no substantive changes. These revisions represent technical corrections related to the placement of a section only, moving the Attachment H-21-A compliance language to its correct location and restoring Attachment H-21 to its proper original state so as to correct the error described above, and do not have any textual or substantive revisions.

III. Effective Date

ATSI requests an effective date of June 1, 2011 for the corrected tariff sections.

IV. Documents Enclosed

ATSI encloses with this errata transmittal letter:

- The OATT Attachment H-21 section in RTF format only as filed in ER11-2815-000 with no textual revisions in its proper location to restore it to its original form; and

- The OATT Attachment H-21A section in RTF format only as filed in ER11-2815-002, with no textual revisions and remapped in its proper location.
