Pursuant to Section 205 of the Federal Power Act (“FPA”), 16 U.S.C. § 824d,
PJM Interconnection, L.L.C. (“PJM”), hereby submits for filing:

- (i) Attachment L of the PJM Open Access Transmission Tariff (“PJM OATT”) revised to include the City of Hamilton, Ohio (“Hamilton”) as a PJM Transmission Owner.
- (ii) A signature page to the PJM Consolidated Transmission Owners Agreement (“TOA”), PJM Rate Schedule No. 42, executed by Hamilton, and revised Attachment A to the TOA adding Hamilton to the list of PJM Transmission Owners.

PJM requests that the attached OATT section and TOA section have an effective date of February 29, 2012.

I. BACKGROUND

Hamilton owns and operates a municipal electric system serving the electric needs of more than 29,000 customers located in the City and the immediately surrounding communities. Hamilton is located north of Cincinnati, Ohio and is the county seat of

Butler County, Ohio. Hamilton is located within the transmission pricing zone of Duke Energy Ohio, which is scheduled to integrate into the PJM Region effective January 1, 2012. Separate from its local distribution facilities, and located remotely from the City, Hamilton owns 7.4 miles of 138kV transmission between the Argentum substation (owned and operated by the East Kentucky Power Cooperative) to a point near the Fullerton substation (owned and operated by American Electric Power) (“Argentum-Fullerton Line”). Based on the foregoing, as of January 1, 2012, Hamilton qualifies to join PJM initially as a non-transmission revenue requirement Transmission Owner. To further this purpose, Hamilton joined PJM as a Member and signed the PJM Operating Agreement and the PJM TOA pursuant to which it will transfer operational control of the Argentum-Fullerton Line to PJM.¹

Section 1.27 of the PJM TOA defines Transmission Facilities as those facilities that: “(i) are within the PJM Region; (ii) meet the definition of transmission facilities pursuant to FERC’s Uniform System of Accounts or have been classified as transmission facilities in a ruling by FERC addressing such facilities; and (iii) have been demonstrated to the satisfaction of PJM to be integrated with the Transmission System of the PJM Region and integrated into the planning and operation of such to serve the power and transmission customers within such region, regardless of whether the facilities are listed in the PJM Designated Facilities List contained in the PJM Manual of Transmission Operations or successor thereto.” The Argentum-Fullerton Line satisfies these criteria.

First, the line is physically located in the PJM region. Second, the City of Hamilton, Ohio is not a Public Utility as defined by the Federal Power Act, and therefore does not necessarily follow the Uniform System of Accounts. However, the Argentum-Fullerton Line nevertheless meets the definition of “transmission facilities” as defined in

Accounts 350 through 359 of the Uniform System of Accounts (*see*, 18 CFR Part 101). Third, the City of Hamilton, Ohio was approved for membership in the PJM Transmission Owner sector on Wednesday, December 21, 2011, and as of February 29, 2012, the Argentum-Fullerton Line has been demonstrated to the satisfaction of PJM to be integrated with the Transmission System of the PJM Region. As of January 1, 2012, the Argentum-Fullerton Line will also qualify to be integrated into the planning and operation of the PJM Transmission system to serve the power and transmission customers within such region (*i.e.* the load in the City of Hamilton).

Pursuant to Section 7.1.2 of the TOA, a party to the TOA “shall have the unilateral right to adopt a revenue requirement of zero for existing or new facilities and to forgo any right or claim to compensation for providing transmission services under the PJM Tariff or any other document.” Hamilton is joining PJM initially as Zero Revenue Requirement Party to the TOA (defined in Section 1.32 of the TOA) as Hamilton initially adopts a revenue requirement of zero pursuant to Section 7.1.2 of the TOA.

II. DESCRIPTION OF PROPOSED REVISIONS TO THE OATT AND TOA

1. Attachment L to the PJM OATT

The Transmission Owners under the PJM OATT are listed in Attachment L. The PJM Tariff defines “Transmission Owner” as: “(e)ach entity that owns, leases or otherwise has a possessory interest in facilities used for the transmission of electric energy in interstate commerce under the Tariff. The Transmission Owners are listed in Attachment L.”² As set forth above, Hamilton meets the definition of “Transmission Owner.” Therefore, PJM now proposes to add Hamilton to Attachment L of the PJM OATT.

² The PJM TOA contains a similar definition for “Transmission Owners” at Section 1.28.

2. Attachment A to the PJM TOA

PJM submits a signature page to the PJM TOA executed by Hamilton and a revised Attachment A to the TOA adding Hamilton to the list of PJM Transmission Owners. As discussed above, Hamilton qualifies as a PJM Transmission Owner under the TOA because it owns the Argentum-Fullerton Line.³ Therefore, Hamilton is an owner of “Transmission Facilities” in the PJM Region and signed the TOA.

III. EFFECTIVE DATE

PJM requests an effective date of February 29, 2012, for the attached PJM OATT and TOA sections, which is at least 60 days after the date of this filing.


