Re: Amendment to Filing for Purposes of Requesting Deferral of Action  
PJM Interconnection, L.L.C., Duke Energy Ohio, Inc., and Duke Energy  
Kentucky, Inc., Docket Nos. ER12-91-000 and ER12-92-000

Dear Ms. Bose:

On October 14, 2011, PJM Interconnection, L.L.C. (“PJM”), Duke Energy Ohio, Inc. and Duke Energy Kentucky, Inc. filed revisions to PJM’s Open Access Transmission Tariff and certain other documents in connection with Duke Energy Ohio, Inc.’s and Duke Energy Kentucky, Inc.’s (together, “the Companies”) move from the Midwest Independent Transmission System Operator, Inc. Regional Transmission Organization to PJM. On November 4, 2011, American Municipal Power, Inc. (“AMP”) and Indiana Municipal Power Agency (“IMPA”) filed protests to the rates included in the Companies’ filing. No other party protested the filings.

The Companies are currently engaged in settlement discussions with AMP and IMPA in an attempt to settle the issues raised by AMP and IMPA in their protests.

However, the parties need additional time beyond the December 31, 2011 deadline for Commission action in this proceeding to continue those discussions. Accordingly, on December 27, 2011, the Companies and PJM filed a request for deferral of action in this proceeding until no later than January 17, 2012. The purpose of the request was to enable the Companies, AMP and IMPA to continue settlement discussions that, if successful, would resolve all issues in this proceeding. The request was submitted on the condition that it shall have no effect on the requested effective date for the Companies' and PJM's filing (January 1, 2012). The Companies and PJM acknowledged and agree that notwithstanding the deferral the Commission's Section 205 suspension and refund authority was extended until January 17, 2012. AMP and IMPA supported this request.

While the Companies and PJM believe that their December 27, 2011 filing accomplishes the deferral requested therein, Commission Staff has advised that an amendment to the Companies' and PJM's filings in the eTariff database is necessary. Accordingly, the Companies and PJM hereby tender "revised" tariff records in Docket Nos. ER12-91 and ER12-92 that contain no changes to the existing tariff records filed in these dockets on October 14, 2011. (Only one revised tariff record is being submitted in each docket.) These filings are being tendered for the sole purpose of deferring the Commission's actions in these proceedings. Because no revisions were made to the text of any tariff records, no new marked or clean tariff is being submitted for posting in eLibrary.

The Companies and PJM continue to request that their proposed tariff provisions, and the enclosed tariff records, be made effective on January 1, 2012. To the extent necessary, the Companies and PJM request waiver of the sixty-day prior notice requirement in order to permit this effective date. The Companies are moving to PJM on January 1, 2012, and accordingly the Companies and PJM need to have tariff provisions in place beginning January 1, 2012 for the services provided. The Companies and PJM provided more than sixty days notice of the tariff changes, and are making no changes to their October 14, 2011 filing through this filing, which is a ministerial filing solely for the purpose of accomplishing the deferral of action that the Companies and PJM have requested.

Because this filing is ministerial in nature, the Companies and PJM request that, in the event that the Commission determines that it is necessary to provide public notice of this filing, a shortened response period be provided. In addition, while the Companies and PJM requested a deferral of action until January 17, 2012, the Companies and PJM request that the Commission act on the Companies' and PJM's filings in these dockets on an expedited basis thereafter.


