Dear Ms. Brentani:

On September 15, 2011, you filed, on behalf of PJM Interconnection, L.L.C. (PJM), an executed interconnection service agreement among PJM, Hawks Nest Hydro, L.L.C., and Appalachian Power Company (Hawks Nest ISA)¹ and a notice of cancellation of Original Service Agreement No. 1896 (Interim ISA). You state that the Hawks Nest ISA supersedes the Interim ISA and facilitates the interconnection to the PJM transmission system of a 100 MW generating facility located in Gauley Bridge, West Virginia. You further state that PJM submitted the Hawks Nest ISA for filing because it contains language that does not conform to the *pro forma* agreement set forth in the PJM Open Access Transmission Tariff.

Pursuant to the authority delegated to the Director, Division of Electric Power Regulation – East, under 18 C.F.R. § 375.307, your submittal filed in the above-referenced docket is accepted for filing, effective August 16, 2011, as requested.

Notice of the filing was published in the *Federal Register*, with comments, protests and interventions due on or before October 6, 2011. No protests, comments, or interventions were filed.

This acceptance for filing shall not be construed as constituting approval of any service, rate, charge, classification, or any rule, regulation, or practice affecting such rate or service provided for in the filed documents; nor shall such action be deemed as recognition of any claimed contractual right or obligation affecting or relating to such service or rate; and such acceptance is without prejudice to any findings or orders which have been or may hereafter be made by the Commission in any proceeding now pending or hereafter instituted by or against PJM.

This order constitutes final agency action. Requests for rehearing by the Commission may be filed within 30 days of the date of issuance of this order, pursuant to 18 C.F.R. § 385.713.
