Dear Ms. Brentani:

On September 29, 2011, you filed, on behalf of PJM Interconnection, L.L.C. (PJM), an executed Interconnection Service Agreement and an executed Interconnection Construction Service Agreement among PJM, Hog Creek Wind Farm, LLC, and AEP Ohio Transmission Company, Inc.¹ You state that the agreements facilitate the interconnection to the PJM transmission system of a 66.7 MW wind generating facility located in Hardin County, Ohio. You also state that PJM is submitting the agreements for filing because they contain non-standard terms and conditions.

Pursuant to the authority delegated to the Director, Division of Electric Power Regulation - East, under 18 C.F.R. § 375.307, your submittal filed in the above-referenced docket is accepted for filing, effective August 31, 2011, as requested.

Notice of the filing was issued on September 29, 2011, with comments, protests, or interventions due on or before October 20, 2011. No comments, protests, or interventions were filed.

This acceptance for filing shall not be construed as constituting approval of any service, rate, charge, classification, or any rule, regulation, or practice affecting such rate or service provided for in the filed documents; nor shall such action be deemed as

recognition of any claimed contractual right or obligation affecting or relating to such service or rate; and such acceptance is without prejudice to any findings or orders which have been or may hereafter be made by the Commission in any proceeding now pending or hereafter instituted by or against PJM.

This order constitutes final agency action. Requests for rehearing by the Commission may be filed within 30 days of the date of issuance of this order, pursuant to 18 C.F.R. § 385.713.
