***Errata Filing***

Dear Ms. Bose:

On December 30, 2011, pursuant to Section 205 of the Federal Power Act (“FPA”), 16 U.S.C. § 824d, PJM Interconnection, L.L.C. (“PJM”), submitted for filing (the “Hamilton Filing”) in the above referenced dockets:

- (i) Attachment L of the PJM Open Access Transmission Tariff (“PJM OATT”) revised to include the City of Hamilton, Ohio (“Hamilton”) as a PJM Transmission Owner.
- (ii) A signature page to the PJM Consolidated Transmission Owners Agreement (“TOA”), PJM Rate Schedule No. 42, executed by Hamilton, and revised Attachment A to the TOA adding Hamilton to the list of PJM Transmission Owners.

PJM requested that the attached OATT section and TOA section have an effective date of February 29, 2012. PJM now submits this Errata Filing to amend obsolete references to TOA Section 7.1.2 which related to “Zero Revenue Requirement Party”.

## **I. ERRATA FILING**

In the Hamilton Filing, PJM cites and quotes Section 7.1.2 of the TOA, related to “Zero Revenue Requirement Party” because Hamilton is joining PJM initially as Zero

Revenue Requirement Party under the TOA which is defined in Section 1.32. PJM now amends the Hamilton Filing transmittal letter because the TOA was amended to, among other things, delete Section 7.1.2 effective November 19, 2011 (the “October 31 Revision Filing”).<sup>1</sup> In the October 31 Revision Filing transmittal letter dated September 20, 2011, the PJM Transmission Owners explain that clarity was provided by changes to the definition of “Zero Revenue Requirement Party” (Section 1.32) which made Section 7.1.2 relating to the same topic “surplusage”. As such, Section 7.1.2 was removed from the TOA.

Therefore, the Hamilton Filing is now amended to correct the outdated references to TOA Section 7.1.2. Instead, PJM now cites the definition of “Zero Revenue Requirement Party” in TOA Section 1.32 which states: “Zero Revenue Requirement Party shall mean a Party that is a Transmission Owner solely by virtue of Transmission Facilities used to provide transmission Service with the PJM Region under the PJM Tariff for which it does not have a cost-of-service rate for such service set forth in Schedules 7 and 8 and Attachment H of the PJM Tariff.”

This Errata Filing does not change the substance of the Hamilton Filing nor does PJM change the proposed OATT and TOA revisions. As fully set forth in the Hamilton Filing, as of January 1, 2012, Hamilton qualifies to join PJM as a PJM Transmission Owner under the TOA and OATT. Moreover, Hamilton will initially be a Zero Revenue Requirement Party to the TOA because Hamilton will not initially submit cost-of-service rate for transmission service under the PJM OATT.<sup>2</sup>
