Dear Ms. Brentani:

On January 12, 2012, you filed on behalf of the PJM Interconnection, L.L.C. (PJM) an Interconnection Service Agreement (ISA) among PJM, Harmony Solar LLC (Harmony Solar) and Jersey Central Power & Light Company.¹ You state that the ISA facilitates the interconnection to the PJM transmission system of a 3.0 MW solar generating facility located in Philipsburg, New Jersey. Further, you state that Harmony Solar shall obtain Capacity Interconnection Rights in the amount of 1.1 MW.

Pursuant to the authority delegated to the Director, Division of Electric Power Regulation – East, under 18 C.F.R. §375.307, your submittal is accepted for filing, effective December 13, 2011, as requested.

The filing was noticed on January 13, 2012, with comments, interventions and protests due on or before February 2, 2012. Pursuant to Rule 214 (18 C.F.R. § 385.214), to the extent that any timely filed motions to intervene and any motion to intervene out-of-time were filed before the issuance date of this order, such interventions are granted. Granting late interventions at this stage of the proceeding will not disrupt the proceeding

or place additional burdens on existing parties.

This acceptance for filing shall not be construed as constituting approval of the referenced filing or of any rate, charge, classification, or any rule, regulation, or practice affecting such rate or service contained in your filing; nor shall such acceptance be deemed as recognition of any claimed contractual right or obligation associated therewith; and such acceptance is without prejudice to any findings or orders which have been or may hereafter be made by the Commission in any proceeding now pending or hereafter instituted by or against PJM.

This order constitutes final agency action. Requests for rehearing by the Commission may be filed within 30 days of the date of issuance of this order, pursuant to 18 C.F.R. § 385.713.
