Issue Status

The Black Start Problem Statement / Issue Charge is utilizing the application of the Consensus Based Issue Process (CBIR Lite). Two packages have been developed, one by PJM and one by the IMM. First read of the packages was done at the July 9, 2020 Operating Committee Meeting, and a first read will be conducted again (per stakeholder request) at the August 6, 2020 Operating Committee Meeting.
