1. ADMINISTRATION

The Committee approved the current Agenda and the Minutes of July 6, 2014 MIC meeting by acclamation. Ms. Laura Walter, PJM, demonstrated the <u>enhanced issue tracking features on pim.com</u> and requested additional feedback from the committee.

2. COLD WEATHER REPORT RECOMMENDATIONS: UNIT MARKET OFFERS

Ms. Adrien Ford, PJM, explained that this problem statement will be addressed in the Enhanced Liaison Committee Process along with Qualified Transmission Upgrade Credit Issue, Energy Storage Participation in RPM, Cold Weather Resource Performance and Gas Unit Coordination Commitment.

3. COLD WEATHER REPORT RECOMMENDATIONS: REGULATION MARKET

Mr. Jeffrey Schmitt, PJM, reviewed a problem statement focusing on a recommendation from the 2014 PJM Cold Weather Report. The committee discussed the problem statement and requested that PJM come back with more information and a more concise problem statement at a later date.

4. POWER METER AND INSCHEDULE DATA SUBMITTAL DEADLINES

Mr. Ray Fernandez, PJM, presented the proposed Manual and Open Access Transmission Tariff Changes from the Market Settlements Subcommittee to address Power Meter and InSchedule Deadlines. The modifications are scheduled to be implemented on June 1, 2015. Further, the OATT modifications will also be made in Schedule 1 of the Operating Agreement as the language is the same. The committee endorsed the proposal with <u>0</u> objections and <u>11</u> abstentions.

5. CAPACITY CONTRIBUTION RECONCILIATION

Ms. Susan Kenney, PJM, presented the Manual and Reliability Assurance Agreement changes from the Market Settlements Subcommittee that would allow Electric Distribution Companies to submit corrections to Peak Load Contribution and Network Service Peak Load assignments up to 12 noon on the next business day. The committee endorsed the revisions with <u>0</u> objections and <u>0</u> abstentions.

6. CORRECTION TO ADJUSTED REGULATION PERFORMANCE COST EQUATION

Michael Olaleye, PJM, presented a clarification around language in Manual 11 and Manual 15 relating to the Regulation Performance Cost Equation. The committee asked to endorse the manual language revisions at the September MIC meeting.

7. VIRTUAL TRANSACTIONS CREDIT REQUIREMENT TIMEFRAME

Mr. Hal Loomis, PJM, presented an update on the reduced credit requirement calculation interval for Virtual Transactions. The committee endorsed this change with <u>0</u> objections and <u>2</u> abstentions.

8. CREDIT SUBCOMMITTEE UPDATE

Mr. Hal Loomis, PJM, reviewed updates on several Credit Subcommittee items. These three items are Demand Bid Volume Limits, Risk Documentation Items and Peak Market Activity Adjustment for Virtuals.

9. <u>TIER 1 CAPABILITY</u>

Mr. Michael Olaleye, PJM, presented an update on the applicability for Tier 1 Capability compensation. The committee will be asked to endorse these changes at the September MIC.

10. ANNUAL DEMAND RESPONSE MAINTENANCE OUTAGE REPORTING PROCESS

Ms. Andrea Yeaton, PJM, presented on the Annual Demand Response maintenance outage reporting process and reviewed the DRS polling results. The committee will be asked to endorse this manual change at the September MIC

Mr. Stan Williams, PJM, presented an update on interregional coordination efforts.

12. PJM INTERFACES

Mr. Joe Ciabattoni, PJM, presented new interfaces being developed by PJM and the process by which they are communicated to stakeholders. Mr. Bruce Bliewies, DC Energy, presented recommendations for public advanced notice of closed loop interfaces. PJM will address the issues and develop a process for moving forward.
