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- Primary Frequency Response (PFR) is an essential reliability product, needed to ensure system reliability and stability in both real-time operations and also during system restoration events
 - First stage of system frequency control (before regulation)
 - Provided automatically by unit governors or equivalent speed control systems
 - Response is in seconds and not controlled by any centralized system
 - Critical for controlling frequency in system restoration event

- MRC approved Sr. Task Force formation at May 25 meeting
- Kickoff meeting of PFRSTF – **July 25**
 - Monthly meetings thereafter
- Key work activities
 - Education on PFR
 - Evaluation of existing state of PFR in PJM and other areas
 - Discussions on potential compensation issues and mechanisms
 - Evaluation of PJM OA, OATT and Manuals
- Expected duration
 - 6-9 months
