DEDSS Charter – Review Requirement

DEDSS Charter Requirement

- Review design standards at least once every two years to ensure the standards are current with industry practices.
- The current Designated Entity Design Standards Taskforce Minimum Required Standards was last reviewed in November 2017

- PJM has completed the technical review of the DEDSTF
 Minimum Required Standards, with PJM technical staff as lead
 and technical input from asset owners (through Transmission
 and Substation Subcommittee)

 - No major industry design practices change are noted since last review
 - No immediate need to revise the current DEDSTF Minimum Required Standards.
