- PJM Open Access Transmission Tariff (Tariff), Attachment P, section 1 and Appendix 2, section 14.1.1 cause PJM increased administrative burden
 - PJM Tariff, Attachment P, section 1 does not contain pro-forma language accounting for circumstances when ICSA supersedes already-effective ICSA
 - PJM Tariff, Attachment P, Appendix 2, section 14.1.1 provides for automatic termination of ICSA upon occurrence of last of four conditions, which can occur without PJM's knowledge
- These provisions can make it difficult for PJM to efficiently administer its service agreements tariff

PJM Tariff, Attachment P – ICSA

- Approve language changes to PJM Tariff, Attachment P, section 1; and
- Approve language changes to PJM Tariff, Attachment P, Appendix 2, section 14.1.1.

PJM Tariff, Attachment P – ICSCA

- ICSA Superseding Language
 - Account for circumstances when an ICSA supersedes an already-effective ICSA
 - Mirroring language in PJM Tariff, Attachment O, section 1

- ICSA Automatic Termination Provision
 - Conforming Interconnection Construction Service Agreements
 - Auto-terminate on PJM receiving notice of the occurrence of the four conditions
 - Non-Conforming Interconnection Construction Service Agreements
 - Auto-terminates upon: (a) PJM receiving notice of the occurrence of the four conditions; and (b) the effective date of PJM's cancellation of the ICSA in accordance with Commission rules and regulations.
 - PJM will serve the TO and IC with a copy of the notice of cancellation of ICSAs in accordance with Commission rules and regulations.

PJM Tariff, Attachment P – ICSA

- ICSA Termination Language
 - PJM PC and MRC Feedback
 - TO Notification to PJM once conditions are met
 - Format of notification document and method of communication
 - Near term: PDF or similar form that is straightforward and communicates that the Tariff requirements are met, emailed to an address defined in the form
 - Next step: PJM will explore the potential for other more efficient options such as a PJM.com web based form
