



# Capacity Import Limit (CIL) Exception Request Process

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- CIL Requests must be submitted to PJM via [rpm\\_hotline@pjm.com](mailto:rpm_hotline@pjm.com) no later than 5 business days prior to commencement of offer period for RPM Auction
- To qualify for an exception to CIL, the external resource must meet the following requirements at the time the exception is requested:
  - 1) Be pseudo-tied or committed to be pseudo-tied by the start of the auction Delivery Year
  - 2) Have long-term firm transmission service confirmed on the complete transmission path from the resource into PJM
  - 3) Commit to being subject to must offer requirement under the same obligations imposed to internal generation resources by section 6.6 of Attachment DD of the OATT

- Market Seller satisfies these requirements by submitting the following documentation:
  - ✓ signed PJM Capacity Import Limit Exception Officer Certification Form
  - ✓ executed External Resource Must Offer Agreement
  - ✓ executed Reimbursement Agreement
- Market Seller must also provide the following information for an external resource
  - ✓ OASIS reservation numbers for complete transmission path
    - Transmission reservations must be in confirmed status and cover the entirety of the Delivery Year
  - ✓ Letter of non-recallability
- PJM grants approval of CIL Exception request when above documentation is received by PJM

- Current approval of CIL request is focused solely on required documentation
- Current rules do not require any additional analysis to be performed to evaluate feasibility of pseudo-tie prior to receiving a CIL exception approval
- Current deadline (5 business days prior to auction offer window) does not allow adequate time for any analysis to be performed
