Dominion Energy is committed to providing reliable, affordable, increasingly clean energy to power our customers every day. Through planning, operational excellence, and investment in proven technologies, we continue to meet customer expectations and fulfill our obligations as a PJM member.

As our industry faces unprecedented demand growth, we are pursuing an all-of-the-above strategy for both generation and transmission. The High Voltage Direct Current (HVDC) proposal before you—recommended by the Transmission Expansion Advisory Committee (TEAC)—is a forward-looking, resilient solution. Our portfolio, HVDC proposal 275, builds on the TEAC's appropriate decision to plan for the 2032 case and best positions the PJM Region to meet the growing demands of our customers.

Dominion Energy has a strong track record of delivering major infrastructure projects on time, within scope, and with disciplined cost management. PJM can count on us to execute this project responsibly and effectively.

Our HVDC solution delivers unmatched benefits:

- **Direct capacity injection** into Northern Virginia, the fastest-growing load pocket in PJM. This method avoids the added costs and delays of solutions that do not reach Loudoun County.
- **Significant avoided costs**, including an estimated \$1.8 billion in future project savings and nearly \$300 million in avoided costs associated with black start operations and short circuit impacts.
- **Minimal impacts and maximum constructability**, leveraging existing rights of way and fully underground installation to reduce permitting and real estate acquisition risks. Furthermore, planned construction and grid integration will significantly reduce the need for outages.

Dominion Energy believes that this is the right moment for a forward-looking HVDC solution that delivers long-term value to PJM members and their customers. We recognize the scale of our proposal and the responsibility that comes with it. We are committed to delivering value to our customers and all stakeholders across the PJM Region if this project is awarded.

Dominion Energy and PJM are uniquely positioned to meet the needs of one of the fastest growing load regions in the world with the right technology and precise execution, deployed at the right time. We appreciate the TEAC's recommendation and the PJM Board for its consideration.
