# 1. <u>Capacity Market Enhancements – ELCC Accreditation Methodology</u>

#### Target Completion Date

July 2025

#### **Issue Status**

The ELCCSTF is continuing its work on the ELCC Accreditation Methodology solution options and packages. The ELCCSTF <u>work plan</u> calls for the solution packages work to be completed by July 7, 2025 and for the ELCCSTF to complete an offline vote following the July 7 meeting.

#### Action Requested

Stakeholders are asked to continue to provide input on solution options and packages in ELCC Accreditation Methodology matrix.

Members wishing to participate in the July 7 ELCCSTF vote should also ensure that they are on the ELCCSTF roster and have appropriate voting application access. Additional roster and voting information can be referenced <u>here</u>.

## 2. <u>Capacity Market Enhancements – Data Transparency</u>

#### **Target Completion Date**

May 2025

#### **Issue Status**

Since initiating work on the Data Transparence issue in December 2024, the senior task force has developed a single consolidated package sponsored by Dominion and PJM to improve data transparency and stakeholder understanding of ELCC accreditation analysis.

An offline vote on the solution package was closed on March 25. The ELCCSTF endorsed the Dominion/PJM package with 100% support. The matrix containing the solution package (Package D) can be found <u>here</u>.

The proposed solution and corresponding manual revisions were endorsed by the MRC on May 21, 2025.

# 3. Capacity Market Enhancements – CETL

# Target Completion Date

#### Issue Status

At its 3/18/2025 meeting, the senior task force resumed work on the CETL issue. Stakeholders added interests and design components to the <u>matrix</u>.

At the 4/3/2025 meeting, Tom Hoatson, LS Power, proposed that the senior task force defer the CETL issue until such time that seasonal capacity is undertaken. No stakeholders objected. Michele Greening, PJM, discussed next steps to bring this proposed deferral to the Markets and Reliability Committee as the ELCCSTF's parent.

At its May 21, 2025 meeting, the MRC endorsed the motion to defer consideration of the ELCCSTF CETL Issue Charge until such time as the stakeholders undertake consideration of a seasonal capacity construct with 3.699 in favor.
