# 1. Capacity Market Enhancements – ELCC Accreditation Methodology

# **Target Completion Date**

August 2025

#### Issue Status

The ELCCSF is continuing its work on the Accreditation Methodology solution packages. Discussion on solution options and scenario analysis related to ELCC accreditation has continued at ELCCSTF meetings throughout June and July. Solution packages have been offered by Vistra, the IMM, PJM, EKPC, LS Power and ODEC. The updated work plan calls for the ELCCSTF's work to be completed on solution packages in time for an offline vote following the July 25, 2025 meeting. The vote on solution packages will close at 5:00 p.m EPT on July 29.

### 2. Capacity Market Enhancements - CETL

#### **Target Completion Date**

#### **Issue Status**

At its 3/18/2025 meeting, the senior task force resumed work on the CETL issue. Stakeholders added interests and design components to the <u>matrix</u>.

At the 4/3/2025 meeting, Tom Hoatson, LS Power, proposed that the senior task force defer the CETL issue until such time that seasonal capacity is undertaken. No stakeholders objected. At the May 21 MRC, Members passed a motion to defer the CETL Issue Charge until such time that stakeholders undertake work on a seasonal capacity construct. The motion passed with a sector-weighted vote tally of 3.699.
