Cause: Planned Maintenance in MSCS database had an unexpected impact. Actions Taken Notification was sent to the impacted users. After the maintenance was complete, data was posted in accordance with the feed descriptions.

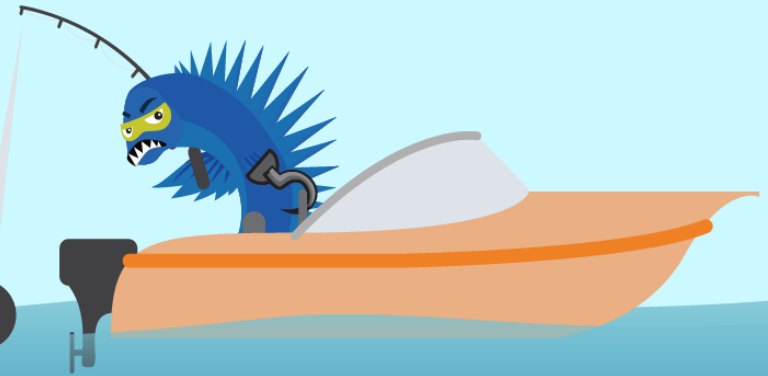
