Intended Audience: PJM Regulation Market Participants and Stakeholders

What's Happening in Phase 2:

One bidirectional signal product → Two products Regulation Up & Regulation Down

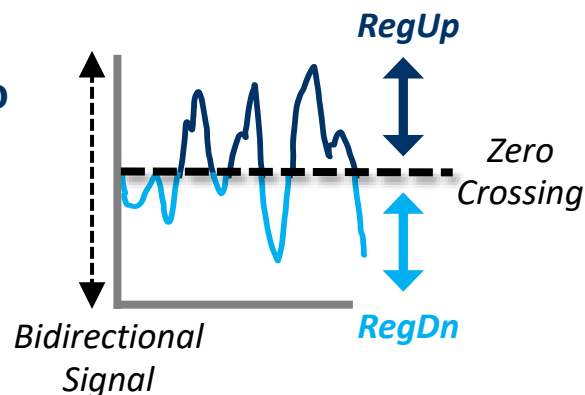
Each product with its own requirement, commitment, pricing and settlement

Telemetry signal changes and new operator responsibilities

Signal conversion testing (Now – Nov. 25, 2026)

Regulation-assigned resources will be able to follow RegUp or RegDn, or RegUp and RegDn signal(s).

Only one product will be deployed at a time.

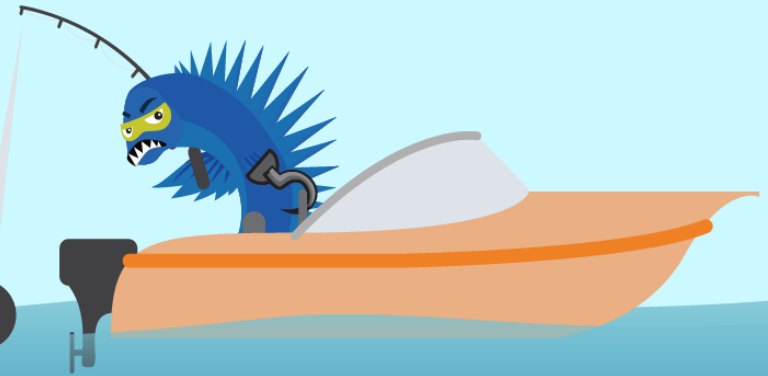
