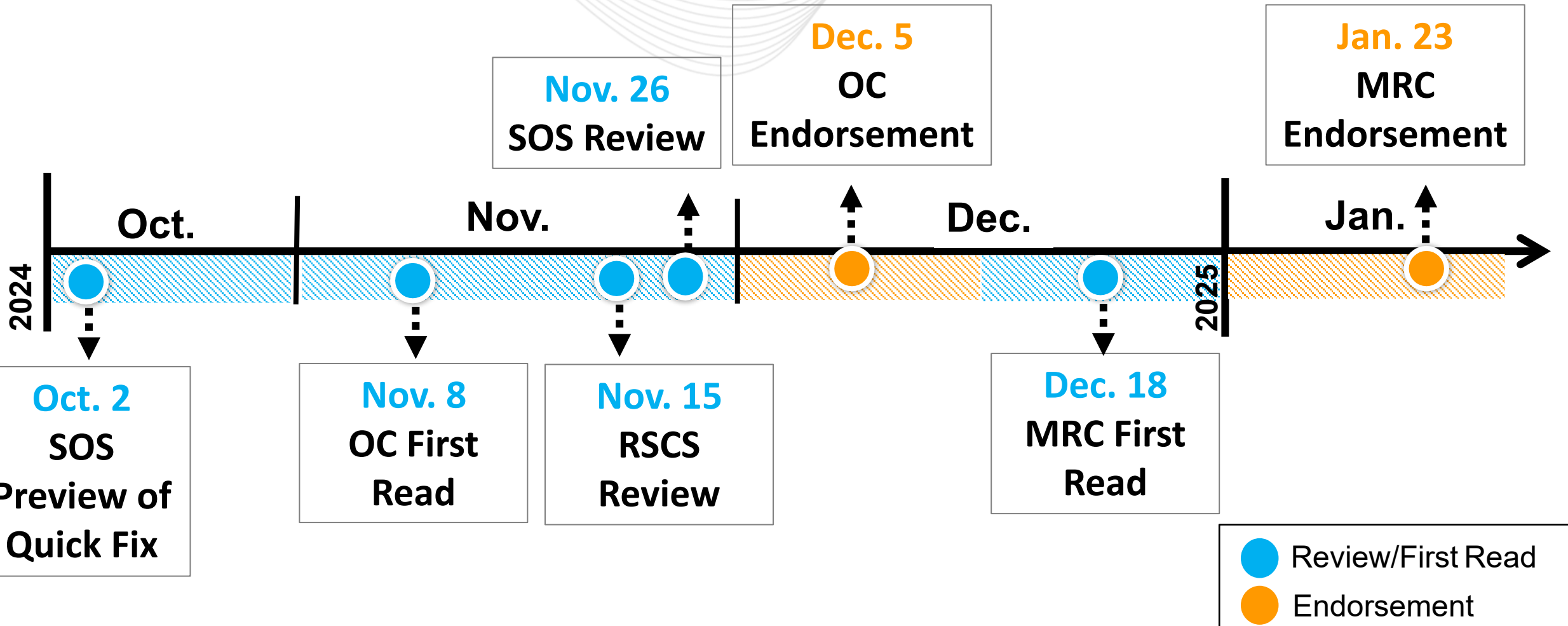

- Section 3.2.4.1 Alternate Com Method During EMS Outages
 - Proposed revisions provide greater clarity regarding PJM's alternate communication method that can be used as a backup for a wide variety of large-scale SCADA failure modes
 - Proposed revisions include updated text (#2 section of for alternative non-EMS SCADA communications with latest description and guidance, including a diagram.4.1, Requirements for Electronic Alternate Data.

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- Attachment E: Reliability Guidelines to Mitigate the Unplanned Loss of EMS Real Time Assessment (RTA) Capabilities
 - Proposed revisions provide greater clarity regarding PJM’s “View-Only Mode” that allows PJM to negate incoming links during windows of planned maintenance, where risks of incorrect data are elevated.

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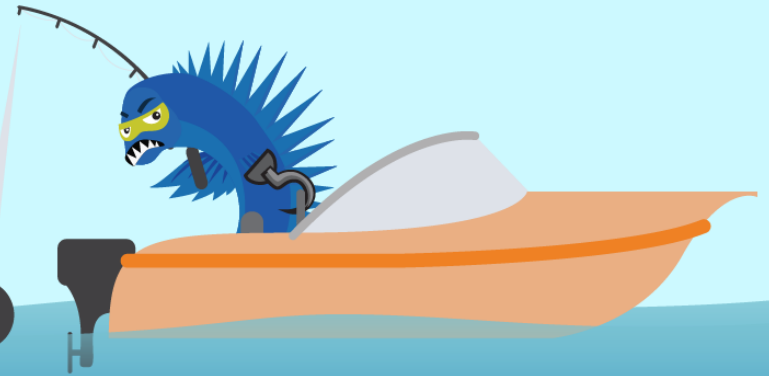
